

The estimated cost of a contractor new construction for this ramp and stairs combination is \$6,800.00 and between 80-100 hours to build. Pioneers members Dennis Gilreath, Mike Donovan, Harold Burdick, Ken Berling, Tony Verreos and his wife, Hilsa, put in 35 hours, and the Brisbane Lion's Club added five very important hours of skilled pre-moving deconstruction and heavy lifting (Marc Salmon and Dan Carter). The plan is to store the ramp, railings and posts at Camp Herms, and custom reinstall them to the Medic's Lodge after we complete foundation supports etc. this summer.
